**Auramex announces successful completion of synthetic aperture radar survey**

Auramex Resource Corp. ("Auramex") announces preliminary results of a 2015-2016 geophysical remote sensing survey carried out on the Company's Georgia River Mine and Georgie Girl properties south of Stewart, British Columbia. The survey comprised acquisition of synthetic aperture radar (SAR) data from the European Space Agency's Sentinel 1A satellite and was completed successfully in mid-2015. Auracle Geospatial Science Inc. of Qualicum, B.C. carried out processing of the SAR data using their proprietary technology and methodology and geological interpretation of the data is ongoing at the time of writing.

Preliminary interpretation of the processed SAR data indicates that structures mapped during 2010 fieldwork near the Georgia River Mine are visible in the geospatially rectified image of the SAR data. The structures are visible not only on ridge crests but also under glacial and vegetative cover on the ridge sides. Two structural sets, southeasterly-striking and northerly-striking, host the gold-bearing mineralization at the Georgia River Mine, in proximity to intrusions of the Early Jurassic Texas Creek Plutonic Suite. These structural sets are present throughout the property.

As a consequence of these preliminary observations, it was recommended that higher-resolution SAR data from the Canadian Space Agency's RadarSat-2 satellite be acquired for processing as part of a planned case study on known, intrusion-related gold mineralization in the Stewart area. In addition, it was recommended that a comprehensive compilation be made of all geological data relevant to the Georgia River Mine and Georgie Girl properties. These data will then be fused with the results of both the Sentinel and RadarSat-2 SAR surveys to generate comprehensive, data-driven, information based exploration model for Auramex properties in the Stewart area. The data compilation is in progress at the time of writing.

The geological work has been carried out at Auracle Geospatial Science Inc.'s Qualicum facility by Dr. Paul Metcalfe P.Geol., vice-president of exploration for Auramex and a Qualified Professional under National Instrument 43-101.
